Year 4 had a wonderful time at Lowestoft station where their art work was on show. A huge congratulations to the winners, especially Ruby who came in first place.

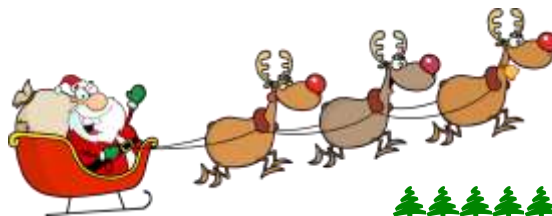
