The reserve dates have been changed to the following:

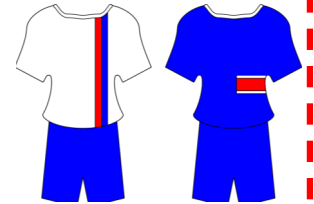
5th July Reserve Sports Day for Years 3/4—am & 5/6—pm.
