We had a number of children coming to school in the incorrect uniform at the end of last term. Please see below for information regarding the correct school uniform:

School Uniform

- Maroon jumper, sweatshirt or cardigan with or without school logo.
- White shirt/blouse or polo shirt
- Plain black tailored trousers
- Plain black skirt - knee level length or just below
- Black, flat-heeled sensible shoes (or closed heel and closed toe sandals in the summer)
Trainers are NOT permitted
- Black plain flat-soled boots
- Grey or white socks
- Natural/grey/black/dark burgundy plain tights or knee highs
- Girls may wear red and white checked dresses in summer
- Boys and girls may wear smart tailored black shorts in summer (Not sports shorts)
- The only jewellery items allowed are stud earrings and a watch

P.E. / Games Kit

- Plain burgundy polo shirt - with or without school logo
- Plain black shorts - with or without school logo
- Outdoor trainers (trainers are not to be worn for indoor P.E.) Black plimsolls for indoor P.E.
- Tracksuit (plain colour)
- A hair band to tie back long hair
