



P.E. and Sport at North Denes Primary School.

Pupils at North Denes Primary have two hours of PE a week.

This is carefully planned, delivered and evaluated and is enhanced through the schools highly experienced, permanent fully qualified PE Instructors.

Expert coaches are sought in specialised areas and cover topics across the different aspects of the curriculum. The school also offers an extensive range of extracurricular sports clubs for which there is no charge.

Our school encourages all of the pupils to have a healthy and successful lifestyle by promoting inclusion into sport through a child's interest; this may be through inter-house competitions or lunchtime clubs where all are invited to participate.

Some extracurricular activities offered, such as sailing and horse-riding, do incur a cost. However, we always negotiate to ensure a discounted price is offered.

We strive to differentiate our service and are thus fully inclusive to the needs of all pupils.

As a school we attend the SEND Norfolk School Games where our pupils compete against other schools, offering pupils the opportunity to experience a wide range of activities.

We are committed to working with other schools in the local area and we take part in a wide variety of inter-school competitions and tournaments such as netball, football and hockey.

We have a large school hall which houses a wide variety of gymnastic apparatus. Additionally, we are extremely lucky to have extensive school grounds. These factors enable our pupils to reach their full potential and thus support their PE curriculum.

Swimming lessons are included in the curriculum for pupils in year 3 and 4. Swimming lessons are also provided for any non-swimmers in year 6.

Sports Premium Funding

The government has chosen to invest in Primary School Physical Education and School Sport for 2015-2016. They have done this by allocating £9311.00 to be spent in any way the school thinks best to improve the teaching and learning of PE and sport in their individual school.

How Sports Premium is being allocated

We are using the funding at North Denes Primary to ensure that children have the best qualified P.E. Instructors during their P.E. lessons. This has included buying in training and support for Instructors from our local sports partnership. Some of the funding has been used to purchase specialist qualified coaches to work alongside our Instructors. In addition, we have used the money to promote a healthy and active lifestyle through targeted lunchtime and afterschool clubs. We have employed a qualified dance teacher to coach pupils for the Cluster performance at the Britannia Theatre.

Necessary equipment, to enhance the teaching, has also been purchased, also travel costs have been met to enable us to participate in various sporting competitions.
