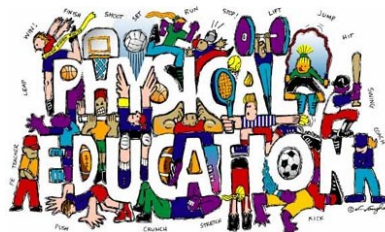
Wednesday Afternoon—6 Oak & & 6 Maple
