### WOW MOMENT

### ENGAGE PHASE

During this phase, the children will ...

Research the difference between being famous and being a hero.

Understand what being a hero means.

Identify heroes and heroines and understand what makes them so.

### DEVELOP PHASE

During this phase, the children will ...

Find out about aspects of Nelson's life –  
Childhood/family; ships/career; battles; wounds/death.

Find out what life was like at sea.

### INNOVATE PHASE

During this phase, the children will ...

Using art to draw seascapes; Nelson portraits; make commemorative plates.

Find out what links and connections Nelson has to Great Yarmouth using local maps; yellow pages; Google maps.

### EXPRESS PHASE

During this phase, the children will ...

decide if Nelson was a good or bad leader.

Use artefacts to imagine what life was like on-board ship.

Use drama to re-enact punishment of the time.

### English Skills

Retrieve, record and present information from a range of non-fiction sources.

Use a wide range of devices to build sentences and paragraphs

Use key facts and research to create a biography.

Use imaginative vocabulary to compose a poem of Nelson's life and death.

### Maths Skills

Angles – measuring using protractor; naming different angles. Finding missing angles

Timetables and Line Graphs – Reading and interpreting timetables. Complete information in a table. Solve word problems using information on line graphs.

Fractions, decimals and percentages. Column addition and subtraction
