ENGAGE PHASE

During this phase, the children will ...

- Learn about the differences between deciduous and evergreen trees.

DEVELOP PHASE

During this phase, the children will ...

- Sort animals into their habitats.
- Draw or paint a picture of a woodland creature.
- Build a nest or den for a woodland animal.
- Identify basic parts of a flowering tree or plant.
- Identify and name common flowers and trees.
- Make a woodland crown.

INNOVATE PHASE

During this phase, the children will ...

- Write a short letter.
- Make a list of preparations needed.
- Make an animal mask to wear.
- Follow the trail left by the animals.
- Collect natural treasures on the way.
- Make natural decorations to hang in trees.

EXPRESS PHASE

During this phase, the children will ...

- Compose sentences and record in order.
- Learn about the work of the woodland trust.
- Share what they have learned about teamwork.
- How have they helped the environment?
