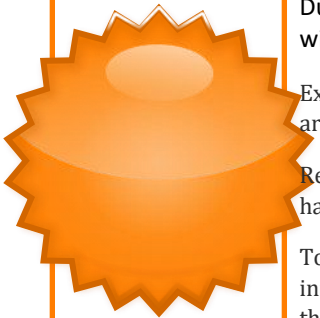
Our topic this term is:

ENGAGE PHASE

During this phase, the children will ...

Find out where and why the Saxon traders settled in Britain

Explore the everyday life of Anglo-Saxon settlers.

Use OS maps to find evidence of Anglo Saxon Sites.

INNOVATE PHASE

During this phase, the children will ...

Make models of Anglo-Saxon homes.

Be 'Sutton Hoo' detectives to explore artefacts found at the site. What can they tell us?

Create a presentation to show what the children have learned?
