ENGAGE PHASE

During this phase, the children will ...

DEVELOP PHASE

- Identify settings and characters in a story.

INNOVATE PHASE

During this phase, the children will ...

- Ask our own questions about the things we are learning about.
- Make up music and dances.

EXPRESS PHASE

During this phase, the children will ...

- Perform a song and dance to parents.
- Write a story with support

Literacy Skills

- Learn to recognise new sounds and link them to an action, book and writing phrase.
- Recognise high frequency and tricky words. Two letter words eg. on, as, in etc and spelling words given as homework.
- Give a string of rhyming words.
- Write a sentence with at least three letter words.

Maths Skills

- Counting within numbers to 20.
- Adding and subtracting within 20
- Number bonds within 20.
- Properties of 2D and 3D shapes and patterns.

- Daily reading at home
- Homework projects
- Spelling words.
