<p>Retell the story of the Great Fire of London. You could write a diary, create a story board or write an informative report. Remember to include information about where and when the fire started, why it spread so quickly and how they put it out.</p>	<p>Design an information poster, telling people what they can do to look after our world. Remember some of the ideas from '10 ways we can help our world' e.g. turn off the taps whilst we brush our teeth; turn off the lights when leaving a room.</p>	<p>Write a recipe for a new smoothie - design a carton for it to go in and write instructions on how to make it. Remember to make your carton design bright and colourful (and include a list of ingredients).</p>
<p>Make a junk model - it can be anything you like! Perhaps a tower for Rapunzel? Or design a futuristic car? Maybe a robot - let your imagination run wild!</p>	<p>Design a leaflet to inform people how to take care of snails (or another animal/pet). Where do they live? What do they eat? What do we need to do to look after them? Do they need exercise?</p>	<p>Write a list of items made out of the 'wrong' material and explain why it would not be suitable. E.g. a metal window - because we couldn't see through it; a chocolate teapot - it would melt when we poured the hot water in.</p>
<p>Sketch your view from a window - make sure you include plenty of detail. What can you see? Label objects in your sketch. Write a paragraph to describe your view (use plenty of adjectives!) and remember to include what you can hear / smell.</p>	<p>Tell the story of Rapunzel - can you think of a different ending? Include pictures to help you tell the tale.</p>	<p>Be creative! Draw, paint, take photos, write a story, keep a diary, design a board game...</p>
