Prices

2 year olds- Some families on certain benefits maybe entitled to 15 hours free education and childcare for their 2 year old. Working families may also be entitled to 30 hours free education . You can check your eligibility on the Gov.uk website. please check your eligibility on the Gov.uk website. We offer additional sessions at £7.00 per hour. (Places are limited and need to be approved by the manager).

3 year olds- All families are entitled to 15 hours free education for their 3 year old and some working families are entitled to 30 hours free education. You can check your eligibility on the Gov.uk website. We offer extra sessions at the cost of £5.00 an hour.

Currently we offer 6 hour full day sessions (9-3) or 3 hour morning or afternoon sessions (8.30-11.30 or 12.30-3.30.)

Breakfast club 8.00am- 8.30am at an additional cost of £2.50.

Places are limited and need to be booked in advance.




Nursery day

The children leave their adults at the door and come into nursery at 8.30am and 9.00am and play with a variety of activities that have been selected to cover all areas of learning. The children are encouraged to hang up their own bags and coats and to put their packed lunches on the trolley.

9.20- The children then listen to a story whilst eating their toast. The children will then have an adult led group learning activity planned specially to cover a specific area of learning.

9.40- The children have access to free flow to both the inside and outside area.

10.30-11 - The children have access to an independent snack time the children are encouraged to peel their own fruit, pour their own drink and tidy up by washing their cup up and putting any rubbish in the bin.




11.15- The children have another story and a song time. The children who go home will collect up all their belongings and get ready to go at 11.30. The children who stay for lunch will then wash their hands and collect their packed lunches. The children choose who they want sit next to and are encouraged to be independent in opening and eating their lunches. This routine is then repeated (without toast) in the afternoon for the children who join us after lunch.

What your child will need during their time in nursery.

Please send your child in clothes that are easy to remove and are comfy- such as leggings and tracksuit bottoms. **Please do not send your child in skinny jeans, as they find these hard to take down when they are using the toilet. We encourage the children to be independent when using the toilet.**

It is advised that children wear comfortable shoes such as trainers with velcro as they will be doing lots of physical activities in the




outside area. They may also take their shoes off to change into wellies and will be encouraged to put them back on independently so laces can be difficult for little fingers.

Your child is going to be playing in sand, water, mud and with paint so they will get dirty. Wearing old clothes, or ones you don't mind getting dirty, is best.

We have a lot of children come to nursery during the week so **please name all their belongings** as it makes it easier to identify and send home again.

Nappy changing- If your child is in nappies, they need to have a supply of nappies and wet wipes in a named bag every time they attend nursery. If your child is in for a 3 hr session, we will only change their nappy if they soil themselves or they are really wet. We also ask that you put a clean nappy on your child before they attend nursery.



We have children who are allergic to nuts so we are a nut free school. If your child has a packed lunch we ask that you do not put anything with nuts in it.

We are pleased to offer your child a place at North Denes nursery.

Please come to the nursery door at your start time and the nursery staff will greet you.

Any changes in hours have to be cleared by the nursery manager and must be put in writing at the end of a half term. Changes can only be made at the beginning of the following half term due to staffing.
